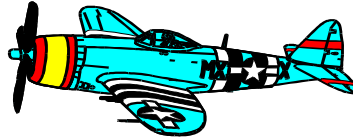

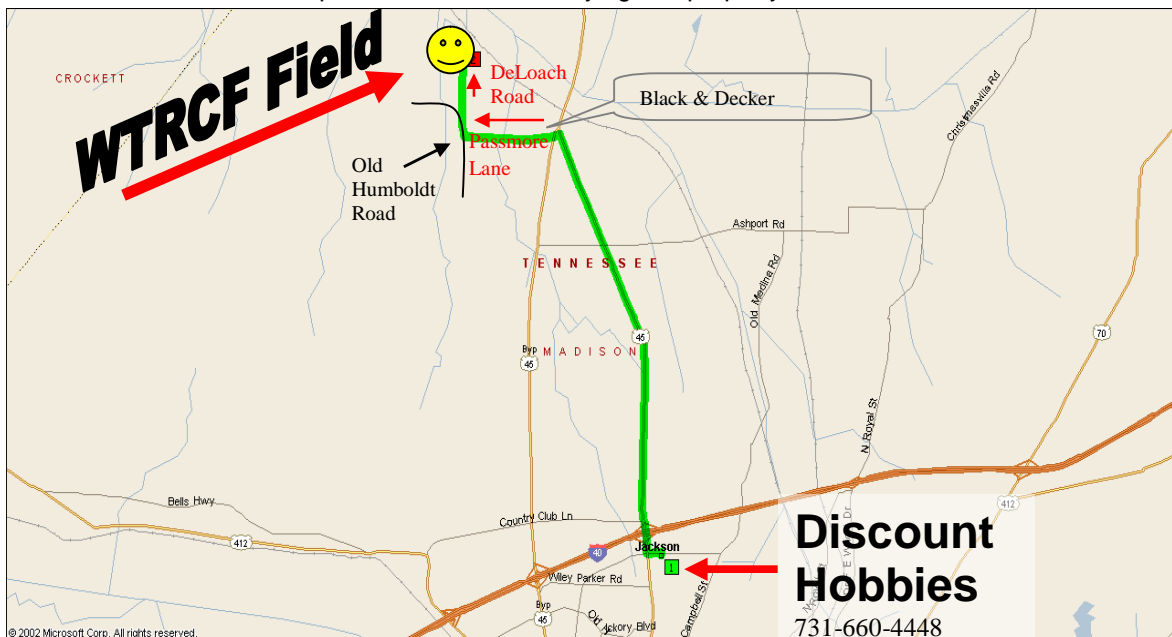
How to Find  
**THE WEST TENNESSEE R/C FLYERS**  
Flying Site

The WTRCF flying site located on the north side of Jackson and is adjacent to the Jackson Energy Authority Middle Fork Water Treatment Facility.

Take 1-45 North or the 1-45 Bypass North to Passmore Lane. Go west on Passmore Lane approximately 1.2 miles until it dead-ends into Old Humboldt Road.

Turn right (north) onto Old Humboldt Road for about 1/4 mile to a 3-way stop.

Go straight onto DeLoach Road and follow it all the way past the houses to the gravel parking lot at the water treatment facility. At that point you will see a gravel road that will go around the west side of the water treatment plant and north to the flying site property.

**Spectators Welcome**

**All Pilots must be WTRC members or their guests and show proof of valid AMA license.**

The WTRC club is a non-profit, non-discriminatory organization requiring annual adult dues of \$80.00 to cover the costs of lawn (runway) and road maintenance. In order to help promote the hobby to youngsters, those under 19 years of age on March 1<sup>st</sup> may Join the club at no charge. WTRC is a chartered club of the Academy of Model Aviation (AMA), which is a national organization promoting the hobby and supporting the efforts of each local club. WTRCF honors and obeys the AMA National Safety Code as well as our local flying site rules. All members are required to have a valid AMA license, which provides \$2.5 million liability insurance. The AMA fee for adults is \$60.00 per year and those under 19 pay only \$1.00 to the AMA.
